AN ACT Relating to Outdoor Religious Signs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 20, § 111, amended. Section 111 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence, to read as follows :

'Signs and displays of a religious nature which do not carry commercial advertising shall be exempt from the payment of fees otherwise required by this chapter.'
