STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Clothing Allowance for Detectives and Police Matron of Police Department of City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 7-A, amended. Section 7-A of article IX of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by chapter 191 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby amended by inserting after the 1st sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'The city shall supply male members of the police department who do not wear uniforms a clothing allowance not to exceed \$100 annually.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 11, amended. Section 11 of article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding after the 3rd sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'The city shall provide for the police matron a clothing allowance not to exceed \$100 annually.'
