RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for 1952 Educational Subsidy to Towns.

Educational subsidy to towns; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$379,638 from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to be paid to the several towns for 1952 general purpose educational aid to cities, towns, plantations and community school districts.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The 1952 educational aid to the several towns was paid by the state in an amount equal to about 93% of the aid. The purpose of this resolve is to pay the remaining 7% due the towns.
