STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Reporter of Decisions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 92, § 3, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 3 of chapter 92 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 57 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'The reporter may retain of said profits received by him the sum of \$1,500 per year for clerk hire, stationery, postage, expressage and incidental expenses.'
