STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Bridges and Culverts on Certain Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Bridges and culverts on certain roads provided for. The state highway commission is hereby authorized and directed to expend the sum of \$5,000 annually for the construction and repair of bridges and culverts on the unimproved portion of the road which begins at Sourdnahunk Field, T. 4, R. 10, Piscataquis county; thence to Sourdnahunk Lake, T. 5, R. 10; thence to Dwelly pond and McCarthy's, which is located on the south branch of Trout brook; thence to the end of the designated state aid road in T. 6, R. 8, Penobscot county, a distance of approximately 30.5 miles. Those portions, however, for which state aid may be available are excepted from the provisions of this act.
