STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting Hunting Within One Hundred Feet of Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 68-A, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 68-A to read as follows:

'Sec. 68-A. Prohibiting hunting within one hundred feet of highway. It shall be unlawful to hunt within 100 feet from the nearer outside line of the traveled way of any highway accessible to motor vehicles.'
