STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Number of Justices of Superior Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 94, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 94 of the revised statutes, the 1st sentence, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The superior court, as heretofore established, shall consist of **7** 10 justices, and such active retired justices as may be appointed and serving on said court, learned in the law and of sobriety of manners.'
