AN ACT Relating to the Cousins and Littlejohns Islands Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1925, c. 27, § 2-A, additional. Chapter 27 of the private and special laws of 1925 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 2-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 2-A. Taxes collected. The town of Yarmouth shall annually pay to the treasurer of the said village corporation, out of taxes collected from the inhabitants and estates of Cousins and Littlejohns islands, a sum equal to 75% of all the taxes so collected, exclusive of the county tax.'
