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**RESOLVE, Authorizing Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game to Grant Extension to Remove Lumber from Land in Franklin County.**

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**Extension to remove lumber in Franklin county, granted. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized to grant to Timberlands, Inc., an extension of time not exceeding 2 years to remove the lumber and pulp from land in Franklin county owned by the state and purchased from the heirs of Frederick Wheeler in 1952.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the time the state purchased this land by deed recorded in Franklin Registry of Deeds, Book 323, Page 135, the heirs of Frederick Wheeler retained a one-year reservation to all merchantable timber and pulp. This reservation has been given to Timberlands, Inc., and more time is needed. This resolve will in no way affect the primary mission of land use planned by the department of inland fisheries and game.
