COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 418, L. D. 1126, Bill "An Act Relating to Admission Age for Maine School for Deaf."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last paragraph thereof and inserting in its place the following paragraph:

"Sec. 171. Admittance of children to school. With the consent of its parent or guardian, the department may admit to said school for a term not exceeding 12 16 years, any deaf and dumb child residing in this state and not less than 5 2 years of age, whe-shall-net-be-withdrawn-er-discharged frem-said-scheel,-except-with-the-censent-ef-the-department er-the-geverner-and-eeuneil,-and the sums necessary for the support and instruction of such children while attending said school shall be paid by the state.!"
