IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Tuition Contracts Between Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 96, amended. The 1st sentence of section 96 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Any town which does not maintain a free high school of standard grade may from year to year authorize its superintending school committee to contract for I to 5 years with and pay the superintending school committee of any adjoining town or towns, or the trustees of any academy located within such town or in any adjoining town or towns, for the schooling of pupils within said town in the studies contemplated by section 89.'
