STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Naomi G. Davis of Palermo.

Naomi G. Davis; retirement credit. Resolved: That Mrs. Naomi G. Davis of Palermo be given credit for a sufficient number of years of teaching service to qualify her for a retirement benefit under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes, as amended, for teachers who have completed at least 25 years of creditable teaching service.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Naomi G. Davis claims to have taught over a considerable period of time beginning with 1895 and ending in 1945. It appears that based on the best evidence of her teaching service that can be produced that she is some short of the required 25 years of service which would entitle her to at least the minimum retirement benefit provided for under the law for that particular period of time; hence the introduction of this resolve to establish her eligibility for such benefits. Mrs. Davis is presently in her 74th year.
