IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Freelow Crummit, of Whitefield.

Freelow Crummit; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$110.10 from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to Freelow Crummit, of Whitefield, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his motor cycle by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred in June, 1951, when a deer jumped in front of the motorcycle owned by Freelow Crummit. Damage occurred to the extent of \$210.10, \$100 of which was paid by the state in August of 1951. Mr. Crummit is asking for compensation for the remaining \$110.10.
