STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Medical Aid for Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 335-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 335-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 335-A. Medical aid. Any member of the Penobscot tribe who is on the census list and who so requests shall be entitled to medical aid. Any aid so contracted shall be paid for out of the legislative appropriation for the tribe.'
