STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Apprentices in Hairdressing and Beauty Culture Shops.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § **215-A, additional.** Chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 215-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 215-A. Number of apprentices employed. Any person, firm or corporation operating a beauty shop may employ 1 apprentice for each 2 operators in such shop who are registered for the practice of hairdressing and beauty culture.'
