SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1043, L. D. 1185, Bill "An Act
Relating to Bounty on Bears."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the 1st
line thereof, the following abbreviation and figure: "Sec.
1."

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following section:

"Sec. 2. R. S., c. 33, §59, amended. The 2nd sentence
of section 59 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as
revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

!The fee for a non-resident or alien for a trapping license
shall be \$200, except that the fee for a non-resident or
alien for a license to trap bear only shall be \$10.!
