STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Fines and Costs for Violation of Truck Weight Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 19, § 100-B, amended. The first part of section 100-B of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 323 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Any person who violates any provision of section 100 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor on account of each such violation, and for each violation of which convicted shall be punished by a fine and costs of court which fine and costs of court shall not be suspended, of'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 19, § 100-B, amended. The last paragraph of section 100-B of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 323 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'In addition to the penalties above provided for, the court shall may impose an alternative jail sentence of not more than 30 days to be served if the respondent fails to pay the fine and costs imposed by said court.'
