STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Executive Office.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 11, § 1, amended. The first 2 paragraphs of section 1 of chapter 11 of the revised statutes are hereby amended to read as follows:

'The governor shall have his official residence at Augusta during his term of office, and shall keep his office at the state house open either personally or by his private secretary for the transaction of the business of the state during # business days of each week all normal working hours of the state house.

The In the absence of the governor, his private secretary shall be in attendance and the private secretary of the governor shall devote his entire time to the duties of his office.'
