**AN ACT Relating to Acceptance by State of Funds for Unorganized
Territory Capital Working Fund.**

Be in enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 148-J, additional. Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 148-J, to read as follows:

'Sec. 148-J. Treasurer of state authorized to accept gifts, bequests and other funds. The treasurer of state is authorized to accept gifts, bequests and other funds from public or private agencies, subject to any conditions contained therein provided such conditions are approved by the state board of education, to be credited to the capital working fund. When any such gifts, bequest or grant is made for a particularly designated purpose, the amount so received shall be used to reduce the total amount of capital outlay involved in the project designated and due to be returned to the fund as provided in section 148-C.'
