STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Appropriation for Unorganized Territory Capital Working Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 148-A, amended. Section 148-A of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 410 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 148-A. Unorganized territory capital working fund. There is hereby created the unorganized territory capital working fund, hereinafter referred to as the "fund," which shall be a continuing fund in the books of the state, and for which there shall be appropriated the sum of \$140,000 during the fiscal year 1951-52 1953-54 to be used as provided in section 148-B. Any unexpended balances shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account.'
