STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Calais Regional Hospital for Aid to Edmund Lee.

Calais Regional Hospital; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$1,489.86 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the Calais Regional Hospital to reimburse said hospital for hospitalization of Edmund Lee; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On or about 1948, Mr. Lee was walking in the middle of the road and was hit by a car driven by some party from Calais. As a result, Mr. Lee sustained a broken leg and other minor injuries. He was sent to the local hospital by the city manager of Eastport and the hospital authorities were led to believe that the city of Eastport would be responsible, but later it developed that there was some question over his action and the city of Eastport has never seen fit to pay the bill.
