STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Bingham.

Town of Bingham; money reallocated. Resolved: That the sum of \$350 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952 and the sum of \$450 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953, appropriated in favor of the town of Bingham by the 95th legislature to aid in improving the mud conditions on the road starting near Gilman corner and extending to the 3rd class road, so called, be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended for repair of the Gilman Corner road, so called, extending in an easterly direction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The money appropriated by the 95th legislature has not been expended and the Gilman Corner road, so called, is badly in need of repair.
