IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Restricting Sunday River to Fly Fishing Only.

Sunday river restricted to fly fishing only. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation restricting to fly fishing only, Sunday river, located in the towns of Bethel and Newry and the unorganized township of Riley, all in the county of Oxford.
