RESOLVE, Authorizing Survey by Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game to Cooperate with Other States to Reduce Hunting Fatalities.

Survey by commissioner of inland fisheries and game; authorized. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, or his duly authorized agent be, and hereby is, directed to determine through personal interview which of the states of New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, New York, Pennsylvania, Michigan, Minnesota and Wisconsin may be interested in cooperatively participating with Maine in setting up a joint educational program designed to reduce hunting accidents; and be it further

Resolved: That a full and comprehensive report of the survey be presented to the 97th legislature.
