STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Organization of the Maine Sardine Tax Committee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 252, amended. The last paragraph of section 252 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 2 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The members of the committee shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. They are authorized to select and employ an executive secretary to administer the advertising, merchandising, research and development program, in concurrence with the Maine development commission and the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries, and to fix his salary. The executive secretary, with the consent of the committee, is authorized subject to the provisions of the personnel law to engage sufficient clerical personnel and other employees for the efficient performance of his duties.'
