COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 455, L. D. 1269, Bill "An Act Relating to Licensing of Electricians."

Amend said bill by adding at the end of section 6, subsection I, the following sentence: 'Any person who, being qualified to obtain a license under this subsection, is prevented from making application therefor by reason of service in the armed forces of the United States during the period between the effective date of this act and July 1, 1954, shall have three months after discharge from such service to make such application.'

Further amend said bill by adding after the underlined words "manufacturing plants" in the last line of subsection III, section 13, the following: 'or electrical generating plants'.

Further amend said bill by striking out the period at the end of sub-section VII, section 13, and inserting in place thereof a semicolon.

Further amend said bill by adding the following new subsection, to be numbered VIII, of section 13:

the doing of miscellaneous jobs of manual labor in the course of which some incidental electrical work is done.

Further amend said bill by inserting after the underlined words "any person who makes electrical installations" contained in the 1st and 2nd lines of section 14 the underlined words 'for compensation'.
