STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Collection of Excise Taxes in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 46, repealed and replaced. Section 46 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 46. State tax assessor to make collection in unincorporated places. The state tax assessor through his agents shall receive the excise tax and issue the receipt prescribed therefor under the provisions of section 42 to persons residing in unorganized places in any county. Said assessor, or agent, shall remit said sums promptly to the county treasurer to be added to the road repair tax fund for the unorganized township in which the tax-payer resides.'
