STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Payments to Certain Towns in Lieu of Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 157-A, additional. Chapter 23 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 157-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 157-A. Payments to towns in lieu of taxes. The state shall pay annually to the towns of New Gloucester, Gray, North Yarmouth and Pownal, all in Cumberland county, in lieu of taxes a sum, in the discretion of the governor and council, which will compensate each of the towns in whole for loss of real estate taxes due to state ownership or real estate now used by the Pownal state school.'
