IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT to Provide for the Sharing of Gasoline Taxes with Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 107, sub-§ IX, additional. Section 107 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered IX, to read as follows:

'IX. For payments to the several cities, towns and plantations of 5% of the funds collected from the tax imposed on internal combustion engine fuel, prorated on the basis of population and the number of miles of streets and roads constructed and maintained by the cities, towns and plantations.'
