STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Reclassification of State Aid Highways as Town Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 23, amended. Section 23 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Whenever the highway commission shall desire to designate a state aid highway as a way to be maintained by a town, a public hearing on the designation shall be held on petition of the municipal officers or of at least 20 voters of the town in which such state aid highway is located. The commission shall be sole arbiter of the designation.'
