AN ACT Relating to Conservation of Clams.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 88-I, additional. Chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 88-I, to read as follows:

'Sec. 88-I. Conservation of clams. It shall be illegal to dig or take clams from any of the coastal waters and flats within the state from April 1st to November 1st, both days inclusive, annually.'
