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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Road Between Rockwood and Long Pond,  
Somerset County.**

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**Road between Rockwood and Long Pond; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$250,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954, to expedite the construction of the road between the unorganized township of Rockwood and the unorganized township of Long Pond, located on route #15, in Somerset county. Such appropriation shall be spent under the direction and supervision of the state highway commission. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain in a continuing carrying account to carry out the provisions of this resolve.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

It is understood that it will be a 5-year program to build this road and it is the purpose of this resolve to make the money available in 1953-54.
