STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Sale of Malt Beverages in Unincorporated Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 21-A, amended. Section 21-A of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1947 and repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 174 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

', except that no license shall be issued, nor shall a vote be taken, to allow licensing and permitting the sale of malt beverages either in retail stores or for consumption on the premises in any unincorporated place.'
