IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Joseph A. DiDonato.

Joseph A. DiDonato; reimbursed. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be and hereby is, authorized to pay from the appropriation of the bureau of taxation to Joseph A. DiDonato the sum of \$100; said sum being reimbursement for expense occasioned by his moving from Portland to Mars Hill on June 30, 1952.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Mr. DiDonato was employed as a field examiner in the Sales Tax Division of the Bureau of Taxation. He was employed to work in his home area, Portland. Subsequently it became necessary to fill a vacancy in supervising examiner in Aroostook County and Mr. DiDonato was designated by the State Tax Assessor to fill the vacancy, requiring that Mr. DiDonato move his family to Mars Hill. This move was made for the convenience of the Bureau of Taxation, and not at the request of Mr. DiDonato.
