AN ACT Relating to Immunity for Members of Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 9, § 7-A, additional. Chapter 9 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 7-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 7-A. Immunity for members of legislature. The members of the legislature shall not be liable to answer for anything spoken in debate in either house or spoken before any legislative committee in authorized convention, whether or not the legislature be in session.'
