RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Liberty.

Town of Liberty appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Liberty, the sum of \$1,337.24 from the general fund of the state, being the town of Liberty's share of the grant for aid to the dependent children of Edna H. Higgins.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of settlement has never been decided. Under a recent supreme court decision, the town of Liberty has no recourse at law and must present a claim through the legislature for this aid to dependent children grant.
