RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Roxbury.

Town of Roxbury; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Roxbury, the sum of \$10,000 from the general fund of the state to aid the town in constructing a school building.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Roxbury needs a new school building badly. The town applied for money under Maine School Building authority but loan was not approved because it was over limit of $12\frac{1}{2}\%$ of the town's valuation. This resolve will permit the town to complete its loan with the Authority.
