COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 496, L. D. 1369 Bill, "An Act  
To Revise the Biennial Revision of the  
Inland Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said bill by adding the following new paragraph to  
Section 10 of chapter 33 of the Revised Statutes, as revised: 'All  
funds derived from the sale of licenses under the provisions of  
this chapter shall be used for the propagation and protection of  
all bird life, animal life, fish life, information and education  
on conservation, and other expenses incident for the administration  
of these functions.'

Further amend said bill by striking out the underlined numeral  
"12" in the eighth line of subsection VI of section 63 of chapter  
33 of the revised statutes, as revised, and inserting there-for  
the underlined numeral '10'

Further Amend said bill by striking out the underlined numeral  
"12" in the twelfth line of said subsection VI of section 63 of  
chapter 33 of the revised statutes as revised, and inserting there-  
for the underlined numeral '10'
