HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 499, L. D. 1374, Bill "An Act
relating to Licensing Auctions and
Auctioneers."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following section:

'Sec. 80. Blooded animals may be sold without state
license. The provisions of sections 73 to 79 inclusive,
shall not prohibit any person employed by the owner of
blooded animals from selling the same as auctioneers at
public auction whether licensed by the state or not.'
