**RESOLVE, Providing for Retirement Allowance for Ruth P. Vosburgh
of Augusta.**

Ruth P. Vosburgh; state retirement allowance. Resolved: That Ruth P. Vosburgh of Augusta be given additional credit for service for such time as may be necessary to permit her to receive retirement benefits, based on 30 years of service, under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes. Such retirement allowance shall begin on July 1, 1953 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Vosburgh is the widow of Dr. Stephen E. Vosburgh who, for more than 25 years, was the Assistant Superintendent at Augusta State Hospital and Superintendent at Pownal State School. Mrs. Vosburgh is 63 years of age. Mrs. Vosburgh was employed at the Pownal State School from 1923 to 1925 in miscellaneous work, and from 1925 to 1939 as dietician. From 1942 to 1946 she was employed as an interviewer in Augusta by the United States Employment Service.
