**AN ACT Repealing Town's Share in Aid to Dependent Children
Expenditures.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 22, § 234, repealed and replaced. Section 234 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof :

'Sec. 234. Towns not to be assessed. This state shall not recover from the city, town or plantation in which the child so aided has legal settlement any amounts expended for aid to each dependent child.'
