STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to Fannie Gushee, of Appleton.

Teacher's pension granted to Fannie Gushee, of Appleton. Resolved: That a pension be, and hereby is, granted to Fannie Gushee, of Appleton, comparable with that paid to teachers under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes based on 35 years of teaching service as is now or may hereafter be provided by the legislature, to be paid from the funds of the Maine State Employees' Retirement System. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1953 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Gushee was a teacher for many years. She is now over 80, needy, dependent, has no regular means of support and is in dire need of a pension.
