STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of A. P. Russell, of Berwick, for damage done by State Wards.

A. P. Russell; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$43.48 from the general fund of the state to be paid to A. P. Russell, of Berwick, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for damage to his house and contents by two state wards.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In November 1951 two state wards caused damage at the home of A. P. Russell, by breaking lights, windows, gun, etc.
