### STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Robert E. Towle of Portland.

Robert E. Towle; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$107.59 from the appropriation for the state school for boys to be paid to Robert E. Towle of Portland as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car which was taken by 5 escapees from the state school for boys.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Five escapees took Mr. Towle's car and were pursued by state police. Two rear tires were destroyed and several bullets were shot into the trunk and body of the car.
