STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Clarence G. Ricker of Clinton.

Clarence G. Ricker; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2,000 to be paid to Clarence G. Ricker of Clinton as a full and final settlement of all claims against the state for damage to 1949, bean, corn, carrot and apple crop by protected wild animals, to wit, deer; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The claimant had approximately 13 acres of wax, green and shell beans, 2 acres of carrots and corn, and 41 apple trees of Northern Spies, Yellow Transparents, Duchess, Strawberry, sweet and miscellaneous apples invaded and substantially destroyed by wild deer, for which compensation is now sought.
