STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Joseph T. Sewall of Wiscasset.

Joseph T. Sewall; compensated. Resolved: That the state highway commission be, and hereby is, authorized to settle a claim of Joseph T. Sewall, of Wiscasset, against the state of Maine for the sum of \$1,000 for the taking of approximately 2,000 square feet of land on the east side of U. S. highway No. 1, so called, at Wiscasset, Lincoln county, for the improvement of said highway, being the unsettled part of a claim for other damages sustained which were settled for the sum of \$500 August 31, 1952; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state highway commission took approximately 2,000 square feet of land belonging to Mr. Sewall when they improved U. S. highway No. 1 in 1949. Mr. Sewall requests the sum of \$1,000 to settle his claim.
