AN ACT Relating to Collection of Excise Taxes in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 46, repealed and replaced. Section 46 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 46. Agent of county commissioners to make collections in unorganized places. The county commissioners of each county may appoint an agent to receive the excise tax and issue the receipt prescribed therefor under the provisions of section 42 to persons residing in unorganized places in each county. Such agent shall remit said sums promptly to the county treasurer to be added to the road repair tax fund for the unorganized township in which the taxpayer resides.'
