AN ACT Relating to Journeymen Welders.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, §§ 69-A, additional. Chapter 25 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto 1 new section to be numbered 69-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 69-A. Journeymen welders. Any journeyman welder who makes repairs to any steam vessel which carries a steam pressure of more than 20 pounds per square inch shall make a written report on the same to the chief boiler inspector within 48 hours after completing such repairs.'
