HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1234, L. D. 1428, Bill "An Act Relating to Exemptions from Taxation of Veterans."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined word "<u>estates</u>" in the 13th and 20th lines of section 2 the underlined words 'in the town of residence'.

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined words "war period" in the 15th line of section 2 the underlined words 'for at least 90 days, or who having served less than 90 days was discharged for a disability incurred in the service in line of duty'.

Further amend said Bill by striking out beginning in the 42nd line of section 2 the underlined words "<u>; and in</u> case any person entitled to such exemption has property taxable in more than 1 city or town of the state, such proportion of such total exemption shall be made in each city or town, as the value of the property taxable in such city or town bears to the value of the whole of the property of such person taxable in the state"
