AN ACT Relating to Return of Number of Registered Voters in Elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 44-A, additional. Chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 44-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 44-A. Return of number of registered voters. Within 10 days after the primary state election and the presidential election each city, town and plantation clerk shall make a return on a blank provided by the secretary of state of the total number of registered voters in such municipality at the close of the polls on election day.'
